BACKGROUND/SUMMARY: The State of California has made organic recycling mandatory (AB 341, AB 1826 and SB 1383). These laws require all Cities in California to comply with State Laws. The goal is to reduce waste, greenhouse gas emission reductions, increase edible food recovery and recycling while also reducing food insecurity. A non-competitive grant in the estimated amount of \$27,632 has been made available to jurisdictions from the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle). The grant funds are designated to assist jurisdictions in complying with the SB1383 mandate. The City of Imperial will utilize the funds to assist the Community Development Department's public outreach efforts with education materials and enforcement of SB1383. The City amended Ordinance 812 Chapter 10-B to become compliant with the SB 1383.

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL
AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION(S) FOR ALL CALRECYCLE GRANTS
FOR WHICH THE CITY OF IMPERIAL IS ELIGIBLE**

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (state) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Imperial authorizes the submittal of application(s) to CalRecycle for SB 1383 Local Assistance Grant Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager, or his/her designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Imperial all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are effective for five (5) years from the date of adoption of this resolution.
