DISCUSSION/ACTION: ABATEMENT CLEANUP TO MITIGATE THE HAZARDS AND ENSURE COMMUNITY SAFETY AT 407 W. BARIONI

- 1. Approving an abatement cleanup for 407 W Barrioni to mitigate the hazards and ensure community safety
- 2. Authorize staff to file a lien on the property

BACKGROUND/SUMMARY:

On January 26, 2023, Community Development received a complaint from 407 Barioni's neighbor regarding overgrown, dead trees and rodents on the property, which posed safety concerns. An inspection conducted on January 27, 2023, confirmed that the property had overgrown vegetation and appeared abandoned. Notices to abate the violation were mailed, but the correspondence was returned without updated contact information. Efforts to locate the property owner through research and by contacting the County Clerk's office for tax record information proved unsuccessful and no forwarding address for a living next of kin contact was found.

The neighboring resident has repeatedly raised concerns about the property, including the potential for fire hazards and the infestation of rodents at the property. A citation for non-compliance was issued in August 2023, but there has been no corrective action taken by the property owner.

On August 13, 2024, a notice was posted on the property, and further investigation confirmed that no progress had been made.

Given the ongoing public safety risks and the lack of response or action from the property owner, it is recommended that the city proceed with an abatement cleanup to mitigate the hazards and ensure community safety.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF IMPERIAL AUTHORIZING ABATEMENT OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 407 W. BARIONI AND AUTHORIZATION TO COLLECT SUCH ABATEMENT COSTS FROM THE OWNER PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE 38773.

WHEREAS, the City of Imperial ("City") has properly noticed the owner of the property at 407 W. Barioni, City of Imperial ("Property"), as set forth in the County of Imperial tax roll, that a nuisance exists on the Property; and

WHEREAS, the City has ordered abatement of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the overgrown vegetation at the Property has resulted in a risk to health and public safety; and

WHEREAS, the City has made numerous attempts to have the owner bring the Property into compliance; and

WHEREAS, the City has received no response and no compliance from the efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Development recommends that the City proceed with a summary abatement nuisance at the expense of the owner pursuant to California Government Code section 38773; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Service recommends that the cost to perform such abatement shall not exceed \$8,790.00; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Service recommends that the costs of such expenses for abatement shall be attached as a personal obligation of the owner and a lien pursuant to California Government Code section 38773.1 or 38773.5; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL MAKES THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS:

- 1. The City of Imperial has determined that the vegetation, neglect and disrepair at 407 W. Barioni a nuisance that poses a risk to public health and safety.
- 2. The City of Imperial has properly noticed the owner and made numerous, good faith attempts to obtain compliance from the owner for over one year.
- 3. The City of Imperial has received no response and no appeal from the Property owner related to the order to abate.
- 4. The City provided the owner and opportunity to object to the not to exceed costs during a regular City Council meeting on February 5, 2025; and

- 5. The City of Imperial, pursuant to California Government Code section 38773, is authorized to abate the Property and hold the owner responsible for paying the costs in compliance with California Government Code section 38773.1 or 38773.5.
- 6. The City of Imperial deems it necessary for public health and safety reasons to authorize abatement of this Property's nuisance and collect the costs for such abatement from the owner of the Property in an amount not to exceed \$8,790.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

 The City Council delegates the authority to the Director of Community Services and the City Manager to abate the nuisance that exists at 407 W. Barioni and to proceed with collection of such costs from the owner of the Property pursuant to California Government Code section 38773.
