BACKGROUND/SUMMARY: All three lift stations are needing suction lines to be removed and replaced. Bracing and supports for these suction lines have also failed and will be replaced, as well. This is critical and considered an emergency repair to continuing to provide sewer collection in the area of Monterrey, Mayfield and Paseo Del Sol. If lines continue to fail, these lift stations will not be able to function; each one currently has a failed line and are running at 50%.

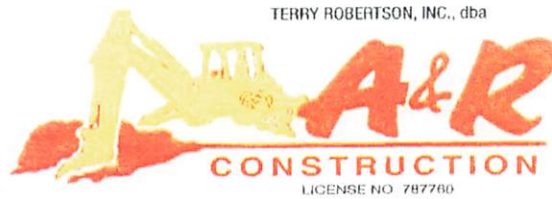

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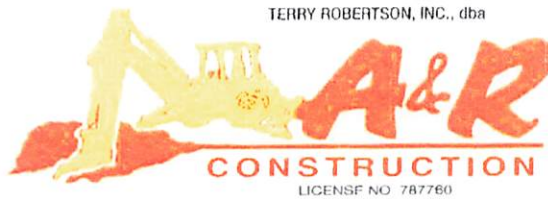
