| SUBJECT: DISCUSSION/ACTION: EMERGENCY TO REMOVE OF A CLUSTER OF EUCALYPTUS TREES LOCATED ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF NECKEL ROAD. 1. AUTHORIZING TO CONTINUE THE EMERGENCY ACTION PER ESOLUTION 2020-59 FOR THE REMOVAL OF A CLUSTER OF EUCALYPTUS TREES LOCATED ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF NECKEL ROAD. | |

| BACKGROUND/SUMMARY: A cluster of Eucalyptus trees located at the north side of Neckel Road and Rodeo Drive intersection are dead or dying and the continued deterioration in the condition of the trees is resulting in tree debris falling onto Neckel Road and if such deterioration is allowed to continue unabated, the amount, size and frequency of the debris falling on Neckel Road could increase. Said falling tree debris would potentially expose persons and property to injury and damage. On September 16, 2020 City Council adopted Resolution 2020-59 authorizing the city manager to take such action as may be necessary in response to said emergency. Since then, Public Services Department has been working with "Utility Tree Service, Inc." removing the trees. The removal of said trees is still a work in progress. | |
